For this reason we answer "Amen!" ("Truly") when the minister proclaims "the body (or the blood) of Christ" before receiving communion, to declare our belief that it is true. It is also for this reason that the raised area around the altar is reserved for liturgical ministers, and the reason we kneel when the tabernacle doors are opened, revealing the physical presence of God.


