Dear Friends,

I wish to share with you the good news of the approval letter that we have received from the Bishop's office regarding our renovation project. Now, we can move forward.

Some months ago, I asked you dear friends to address some renovation needs to beautify our church, our 'House of Prayer'. My hope along with our Parish Council was to construct a new marble altar with a relic, ambo and tabernacle stand. We also envisioned new tile flooring in the sanctuary and the main aisle as well as new carpet in the church and chapel. The proposed budget for this undertaking was above \$100K. With your generosity we were able to raise over \$100K. The next step was to create a formal proposal to be presented to the Diocesan Office. I am very thankful to our Parish Staff, Parish Finance Council, Shelley Murphy, Deacon Lawrence Klimecki and Perry Mejica who helped to put together this proposal which I submitted on August 1st.

The diocesan staff and various diocesan committees evaluated our proposal and recommended the approval with one stipulation, that we add a marble 'baptismal font' at the main isle entrance as part of our project. I do agree with their recommendation and hope that we will be able to incorporate this new addition at this time.

It would be necessary to raise an additional \$20K for our new marble 'baptismal font'. Please prayerfully consider contributing towards this goal. As I have said we are renovating our church for the Glory of God and our Parish Community.

The time line will begin sometime after Christmas since it will take 3-4 months to manufacture, fabricate and install these new liturgical furnishings. My hope is to have the renovation completed before Holy Week.

I express my gratitude to all, for everything that we were able to accomplish so far, and I pray that we will bring this renovation project to completion.

Again, if you wish to contribute to our 'baptismal font' fund please use the renovation fund forms in the back of the church or on our website.
